

## Milner Network Privacy Policy

### HOW DOES MILNER NETWORK COLLECT AND USE MY INFORMATION?

Milner Network may collect and use your personal information to provide you with information about the products or services that may be of value to you. Certain personal information that Milner Network collects about you may be publicly available via government records, telephone books, and other widely available media (i.e. the Internet). However, Milner Network treats all information that you provide to us as non-public.

#### 1. Information that you provide.

\* Milner Network collects the personal information that you provide when you sign up at one of our affiliate websites.

#### 2. Information provided by the affiliate who owns this website.

\* We may receive information from the affiliate about you after the affiliate has contacted you. Any information that we receive from affiliates is covered by this privacy policy and is considered non-public information.

#### 3. Technical Information. We use technology to:

\* Gather technical information from your Web browser (IP address, Browser type, Operating system);

\* Set persistent cookies on your computer; and

\* Collect information about your navigation through our website.

We use this information for routine website maintenance; to establish that you are a unique user; to provide a personalized website experience; and/or for the purposes of assessing the effectiveness of our website, products and services.

If you choose to disable cookies, you will still be able to access most of the website. However, as a security precaution, you may not be able to access certain information that could be used for email harvesting purposes.

#### DOES MILNER NETWORK SHARE MY PERSONAL INFORMATION WITH THIRD PARTIES?

Milner Network may share your personal information:

- \* With the owner of the website that you sign up at.
- \* As required by law.

Examples: We may need to share your information with law enforcement or government agencies in response to a subpoena, state/federal audit or other similar circumstances. Additionally, the law requires that all mortgages and deeds of trust be recorded with the local county recorder's office
